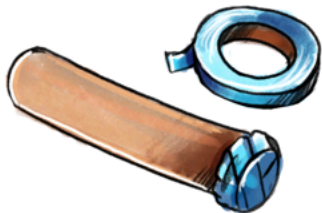


LET'S MAKE A RAINSTICK!

What you need:

- Paper towel roll or wrapping paper roll
- Duct tape or packing tape
- Construction paper
- 1 tablespoon of uncooked rice or popcorn seeds
- Aluminum foil
- Decorating supplies: scissors, markers, stickers, etc...



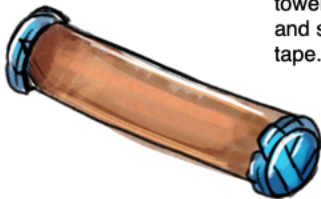
1. Cover one end of your paper towel roll with paper and secure with duct tape.



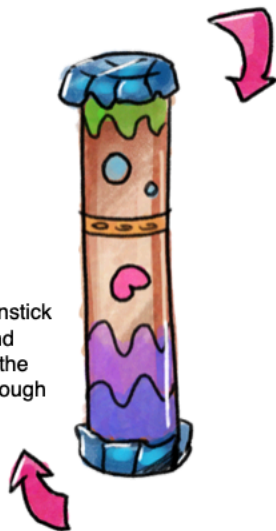
2. Crumple a thin tube-shaped mass of aluminum foil and insert it inside the paper towel roll.



3. With the open end up, pour about one tablespoon of rice or popcorn seeds into the opening.



4. Cover the other open end of the paper towel roll with paper and secure with duct tape.



6. Turn the Rainstick up, down, up, and down. Listen as the "rain" trickles through the stick.

5. Decorate your rainstick with stickers, markers, construction paper or glue. Make sure the ends are sealed tightly.
